

**Report of one day workshop on “NAAC ACCREDITATION” held at Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar
University, Agra under Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) on 21/02/2019**

One day Workshop on “NAAC Accreditation” was held in JP Sabhagar, Khandari campus which was organized by IQAC cell of Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Agra. The programme started at 10.30 am with a University Documentary where photos of development in the University were shown. Then in the Technical session I, a talk on “**Challenges in NAAC Accreditation**” was delivered by **Dr. Ratan Saini** (Co-ordinator IQAC, DEI, Agra). The workshop was formally inaugurated by **Sri Sudhir Kumar (IAS, Retd.)**, Former Secretary, Dept. of Food and Distribution, Govt. of India, who has been Secretary, higher Education of U.P. State earlier in his career. He motivated the college teachers to undergo the NAAC assessment. Vice Chancellor of the University, Dr. Arvind Kumar Dixit advised the colleges administration to go for NAAC accreditation as early as possible and University authorities and IQAC of the University will help them in all possible ways to do so. R.B.S. college affiliated to the University was facilitated for getting A+ grade in NAAC assessment by IQAC cell to motivate all colleges of the University. Workshop motives, objectives of State Govt. Higher Education Council behind this workshop was explained to all the delegates by Prof. Ajay Taneja, Member Secretary IQAC. Inaugural program was conducted by Dr. Sanjeev Kumar, Member IQAC. In Technical session II, talk was delivered by Dr. Dinesh C Sharma, NAAC Assessment expert of U.P. State Govt. College, Badalpur on “New Methodology of NAAC Accreditation” where he in a simple manner with the help of power point presentation explained all the steps necessary for college going into NAAC accreditation. Prof. Sugam Anand highlighted the benefits of NAAC accreditation and Prof. Rajesh Dhakarey, an experienced NAAC assessor gave a talk on “Role of NAAC assessor on site visit”. All the resource persons answered all the queries posed by the Principals, NAAC co-ordinators and IQAC members of the 16 Government colleges and 39 Government aided colleges affiliated to Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar University and also motivated them to undergo NAAC accreditation. In the post lunch session, “**Hands on Training on Computer for filling IIQA Performa**” was given in the University Computer Centre by **Dr. Anil Gupta** and his team. In the workshop, 250 delegates (including teachers and Principals from the Govt. and aided colleges and Agra University faculty members), participated. Workshop ended with vote of thanks by Dr. V.K. Saraswat. Dr. D.K. Garg, Regional Higher Education Officer (RHEO) presence in all the sessions of the workshop was also a motivating factor for all the colleges.
